Spotlight on APFO: Why It Matters for Our Schools

PTA Council of Howard County (PTACHC) is closely monitoring proposed changes to the Adequate Public Facilities Ordinance (APFO), a policy that helps ensure schools and infrastructure can support new housing growth. A 2026 proposal would eliminate current overcrowding protections and replace them with a developer fee — even if schools are severely over capacity.

This change could:


- Remove limits on school overcrowding
- Shift financial burden to taxpayers
- Undermine funding for student education and school construction

The PTA's position is clear: no school should be intentionally overcrowded or underfunded.
