## **Google Meets for Students**

As we continue with virtual learning and students gain the skills they need to navigate the online platform, we encourage you to provide your child(ren) with some independent physical space when possible. To the greatest extent possible, we look forward to increasing students' independence when participating in learning. Live,

synchronous instruction is intended for students, yet we understand that a parent may be nearby to offer technical support. If your child asks for help, encourage your child to raise his or her hand or put the question in the chat box for the teacher to address. This happens naturally in the classroom, promotes greater independence and provides the teacher with observational data about how students are learning.

#### **Dashboard in Dreambox**

Families are able to set up a <u>Family Dashboard in Dreambox</u> for each student. A Family Dashboard allows families to monitor their child's progress and see what information their child is learning. Please consider setting up this dashboard to provide continued opportunities for monitoring progress.

#### Face-to-Face Supports to Small Groups of Students

In the coming weeks, HCPSS will begin providing face-to-face support to small groups of students. Identified students and staff have been invited to complete an interest survey. If you did not receive a survey, it is because your child has not yet been identified for in-person support.

All students who receive special education services will receive an email with directions to complete a survey. ## **Emergency Drill Discussions**

We want to make you aware that during Virtual Learning, students and staff will not be practicing emergency response procedures and drills as they would in the traditional setting. However, HCPSS staff will conduct short reviews of response procedures with students throughout the first semester as part of the Emergency Response Preparedness Plans practice. On Friday, September 25th, teachers reviewed the procedures for an evacuation. On Tuesday, September 29th, teachers will review the procedures for a modified lockdown.

## MAP Testing Information 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th Grade

On Wednesday, October 7 and Wednesday, October 14, students in grades 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade will take the Measured Academic Progress (MAP) assessment. The data from the MAP assessment will help schools and teachers measure where your child is starting the year academically. The HCPSS intends to also give the assessment in winter and spring to measure how your child's learning is progressing throughout the year. The MAP test does not affect grades and the difficulty adjusts depending on how your child responds. It is normal for students to only answer about half the questions correctly. Please note that we are offering two time slots for your child to log into the Google Meet to take this assessment. Your child only needs to attend one time slot on each date and you can choose whatever is most convenient for your schedule.

- Wednesday, October 7th 9:00am-11:00am or 1:00pm-3:00pm-Reading MAP assessment
- Wednesday, October 14th 9:00am-11:00am or 1:00-3:00pm-Math MAP assessment

If your child is unable to attend, makeup testing will be offered during asynchronous learning times. Teachers will share Google Meet information and your student's testing group as we get closer to the Oct 7th date.
