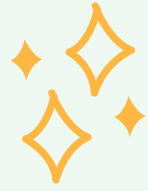




HES PTA NEWS

Incoming Kindergarten Grade Liaisons - URGENT NEED!!! Are you a veteran HES parent with a rising kindergartener? We NEED YOU!!!

We need two parents to step up and be the grade liaisons for the incoming kindergarten class. Current HES parents, who are already familiar with the school and community, and who will be an invaluable resource for brand new families, greatly preferred. Grade liaisons plan and oversee the summer playdates - i.e., pick dates, meet at the recess playground, bring ice pops and wipes, answer questions - for their grade (kindergarten has 3 throughout the summer so these positions must be filled before summer starts); administer their grade's facebook group page (post announcements and flyers, answer questions); coordinate with the teacher team lead to advertise volunteering and community donation opportunities; and plan/coordinate end of quarter and end of year celebrations.

PTACHC delegate - attends monthly PTACHC (PTA Council of Howard County) meetings (first Monday of the month); reports back to general membership; votes on behalf of HES PTA at PTACHC meetings

Spirit Wear Chair and Committee - Choose designs and spirit wear items for the year; promote online sales; sell items in person at select school and PTA events

Restaurant Night Chair and Committee - Works with local businesses to set up restaurant nights benefiting HES PTA; promotes restaurant nights to school and larger community

Staff Appreciation Committee - (Chair, Katie Thorn) Plan and oversee staff support events, such as Welcome Back Breakfast in August, staff dinner/lunch during Parent-Teacher Conference times. Staff Appreciation Week in May

New Families Committee - (Chair, Meredith Mesa Meadows) Welcome new families to the HES community by pairing them with ambassador families, coordinating social and support events to help new families become familiar with things like Canva, etc.

Military Families Committee - (Chair, Carman Henry) Support the needs of military families in our community; POC for new families moving into the community and connecting them with local resources; work with Administration on events like Veterans Day and Month of the Military Child programming



5th Grade Committee Chair and Committee - Working with Administration, plans and oversees special activities for Fifth Graders, such as SCH, fifth grade promotion ceremony, and end of year celebration(s)

Square 1 Art Chair and Committee - Works with Art Department to coordinate Square 1 Art Fundraiser in Fall; POC with Square 1 Art company; ensures artwork by students is completed and delivered to Square 1 Art in a timely manner; advertises Square 1 Art fundraiser

Book Fair Chair - Works with Ms. Haavik to coordinate volunteers for Scholastic Book Fair in December

Ice Cream Social Chair and Committee - Plans and oversees Ice cream Social in September

Trunk or Treat Committee - (Chair, Megan Eller) Plans and oversees Trunk or Treat in October (possibly to be larger and a fundraiser this year)

Skate Night Chair and Committee - Plans and oversees Skate Night Party

Talent Show Committee - (Chair, Kristy Golden) Plans and oversees annual Talent Show

Spring Carnival Committee - (Chair, Faith Hudson) Plans and oversees largest annual PTA fundraiser; researches and retains entertainment and food vendors; solicits community sponsors; organizes large raffle; solicits and oversees day of volunteers

Yearbook Committee - (Chair, Lauren White) Designs and creates annual yearbook

Multicultural Night Committee - (Chair, Ying Li) Plans and oversees annual multicultural night

Fundraising Chair and Committee - Oversees product type fundraisers and coordinates with event fundraising chairs

The numbers aren't fully final yet (some expenses are still being processed) but the news is fantastic with respect to our two largest fundraisers this year, the Harlem Wizards Game/WizFit Program and the Spring Carnival. The combined Wizards programming netted \$16, 273. 74. The Spring Carnival grossed over \$12,000 and should net approximately \$5,000 after expenses are processed. With this large infusion of cash, we are able to fully fund our remaining programs for this year, and comfortably cover our summer and early fall 2024 expenses. Upcoming end of year expenses include Staff Appreciation Week expenses, additional field trips for 3rd and 5th grade, Field Day, Multicultural Night, Simulated Congressional Hearings and end of year celebrations for 5th grade. At the May general meeting, we also passed our summer budget of \$5,465, which covers summer playdates; spirit wear; operational expenses; the back to school expenses, including staff welcome back breakfast; purchase of a portable event speaker; and, funding for a refresh of the teacher's lounge.
