

To provide a safe, nurturing learning environment that fosters individual success through academic excellence and appreciation of diversity to ensure lifelong learners.







## Welcome to HES!

First, model the behavior you are hoping to see. Children get cues about how to feel/act from us.

I will be having virtual lunch bunches with new students to help connect them to our school and each other.

On line learning is difficult for all of us. Give yourself and your children time to adjust. Challenges during the first week will not be challenges a month from now.

Allow your student to be independent while in "class." Decide on a signal with your child to use if they need your help during class time.

Set up the learning environment and encourage your child to participate. Avoid power struggles over this. If your child is feeling nervous about logging in or turning on their camera, give it time. Connect with the teacher to discuss the issue and discuss solutions if it doesn't resolve itself in a few days.
