END OF QUARTER CELEBRATIONS - FALL

As part of our school system's commitment to equity and inclusion, we continue to focus on building community and creating welcoming environments for all students. To continue to support this commitment, Hammond Elementary moved away from Halloween celebrations at school a few years ago. In lieu of a celebration of Halloween that excludes members of our school community, we have implemented End of Quarter Celebrations to acknowledge all students for their commitment to learning. Student behaviors are strategically acknowledged and reinforced in order to foster an environment conducive to academic growth and success. IMPORTANT BUS REMINDERS

As we continue to review and practice our expectations with our students for school, we also wanted to take a moment to review and highlight bus safety expectations and procedures.

The bus is an extension of the school day and students are expected to follow directions of the bus driver and school bus rules. We want to ensure the ride to and from school is a safe and comfortable bus environment for all. In order to ensure the ride to and from school is safe, enjoyable and comfortable for all, families, please remind your bus rider(s) of the following:

- Only students and the bus driver are permitted on the bus. If you have any concerns that arise, please contact the school.
- Make sure students are at the bus stop at least 8-10 minutes before the bus arrives. Students should be prepared to enter the bus when it arrives.
- There is no eating, drinking or using cellphones while on the school bus. Cellphones and food should be away during the school bus ride.
- For their own safety, students must remain flat in their seats at all times while the bus is in motion for their safety.
- Students should use a voice level that is not distracting to the bus driver and courteous of others while riding the bus each day.

We will uplift this same message at school and we appreciate your continued support!
