## PARENT INPUT FORM

At Hammond Elementary School, we value your input. During the next few months, our staff will begin the process of forming homeroom and mathematics classes for the 2023-2024 school year. We invite you to share information about your child that would be helpful for your child's new teachers to learn in preparation for greeting your child on the first day of school. The purpose of this form is to give you an opportunity to share information about your child's strengths, areas for growth, and special interests.

Our articulation process with current and new students is thoughtful and detailed. Once we have gathered this information, our teachers and administrative team will use this information in association with a wide range of criteria, including learning styles, instructional levels, learning behaviors and academic data to better inform placement decisions for the upcoming school year. Thank you in advance for your understanding that this form is not intended to be used to request a specific teacher.

The completion of this form is optional; however, you are encouraged to use this opportunity to provide helpful information for our upcoming school year. This tool, over individual emails, serves as the best communication tool to tell us more about your child.

## 5th GRADE PROMOTION CELEBRATION

The 5th Grade Promotion ceremony will be Tuesday, June 13th from 9:30 am - 10:15 am in the Hammond Middle School Gym. Spectators will be limited to the capacity of the middle school gym. We ask that families consider that we currently have 103 students whose family may choose to attend the ceremony. Beginning at 9:10 am families may enter the HES front doors to proceed to the HMS Gym.

## 5th GRADE SIMULATED CONGRESSIONAL HEARINGS

$5^{\text {th }}$ grade is starting to prepare for their Simulated Congressional Hearing (SCH) that will occur on May 16th. The SCH is an authentic, performance-based assessment where students demonstrate their understanding of the U.S. Constitution. Students display their expertise on topics ranging from colonial life and government to the contemporary rights and responsibilities of citizens in our country. The students present prepared oral statements before a panel of simulated congressional committee members ("judges"). Following the formal presentations, students respond to follow-up questions from the panel. For more information about this program, visit: sch.hcpss.org

## Student Birthdays

- Food, candy, desserts of any kind cannot be brought into school for sharing.
- Birthday party invitations cannot be distributed at school.
- We welcome you to enjoy lunch with your birthday child in the cafeteria. Please visit the front office to sign in.


## Lost \& Found

Our Lost \& Found grows daily but it does not need to. Please label all coats, jackets, lunch boxes, water bottles etc. with your child's name. Otherwise these items may be donated. We invite you to stop into the front office to check the bin for missing items.

The Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) now allows local school systems to repurpose inclement weather days as asynchronous school days. At the discretion of the superintendent, HCPSS will use up to three inclement weather asynchronous days during the 2022-2023 school year. For all the details, please go to the HCPSS Inclement Weather Instruction Plan.

## Outdoor Recess Policy

As temperatures begin to get colder, please remember the guidelines we follow for going outside for recess, PE classes, and students waiting outside for arrival and dismissal. Below is the HCPSS Weather Guidelines/Recess. In short, if the feels like temperature in our area is less than 20 degrees, we will have indoor recess. At this time the "feels like temperature" is 18 degrees. We'll keep an eye on it prior to the start of Kindergarten's recess.

The decision to go outside or stay inside for recess, outdoor eating, P.E., or any other outdoor activity is the decision of the administrator at individual schools and based on the following criteria:

- Temperature and humidity
- Wind chill
- Heat index and air quality
- Age of students
- Length of time outdoors
- Adequacy of the children's clothing
- Condition of the playground
- Falling precipitation (more than a sprinkle or mist)
- Thunder and lightning

Generally, it is assumed that students will be outside for recess, outdoor eating, P.E., or any other outdoor activity when the temperature combined with the wind chill is not less than 20 degrees Fahrenheit or the heat index reading is less than 95.

## Transportation

Changes in afternoon transportation should be submitted to your child's teacher in writing (note or email). For changes that occur after 12 pm, please call our front office team (410-880-5890) to communicate the change and they will provide the information to your child's homeroom teacher. Please communicate all changes no later than noon each day to ensure they are communicated to your child prior to dismissal.
