5th GRADE SIMULATED CONGRESSIONAL HEARINGS

5th grade is preparing for their Simulated Congressional Hearing (SCH) occuring on May 16th. The SCH is an authentic, performance-based assessment where students demonstrate their understanding of the U.S. Constitution. Students display their expertise on topics ranging from colonial life and government to the contemporary rights and responsibilities of citizens in our country. The students present prepared oral statements before a panel of simulated congressional committee members ("judges"). HAVE YOU REGISTERED YOUR CHILD FOR THE BUS FOR NEXT YEAR?



NEW for the 2023-2024 school year, families whose students are eligible for HCPSS-provided transportation will need to register for bus service for the 2023-2024 school year. REGISTER NOW through June 1. REGISTER NOW through June 1.

Families who reside in non-transportation areas are not eligible for bus transportation and do not need to take any action. Find the new non-transportation areas for your school online. Students who receive transportation as part of their Individualized Education Program (IEP) or 504 Plan do not need to register. Please call the front office if you have any difficulties.

KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Kindergarten enrollment for the 2023-2024 school year is underway! Children must be 5 years old by September 1 in order to enroll in kindergarten. Every child who is 5 years old by September 1 must be enrolled in a kindergarten program or have an approved waiver. HCPSS kindergarten is a full day program.

<u>Howard County Food Bank.</u> - access to shopping twice a month for families that meet eligibility requirements. Walk-ins and appointments available.

<u>Columbia Community Care</u>- Provides food, hygiene items, household supplies and baby supplies to families in Howard County. Distribution sites are at the Wilde Lake Interfaith Center, The Other Barn in Oakland Mills, and the Long Reach Village Center, on Saturdays from 10 am - 12 pm. Delivery Service is available, and you may re-order food for delivery every 7 days.
