## HAVE YOU REGISTERED YOUR CHILD FOR THE BUS FOR NEXT YEAR?



NEW for the 2023-2024 school year, families whose students are eligible for HCPSS-provided transportation will need to register for bus service for the 2023-2024 school year. REGISTER NOW through June 1. REGISTER NOW through June 1.

Families who reside in non-transportation areas are not eligible for bus transportation and do not need to take any action. Find the new non-transportation areas for your school online. Students who receive transportation as part of their Individualized Education Program (IEP) or 504 Plan do not need to register. Please call the front office if you have any difficulties.

## **COUNSELORS' CORNER**

Food and Nutrition Resources

<u>Howard County Local Health Improvement Coalition</u> (HCLHIC) has updated their website with local food and nutrition resources. There's a link to a food connection map as well as -brochures in English, Spanish, French, Korean, and Chinese that encompass the entire area!

<u>Howard County Food Connection Map.</u> - The Howard County Food Connection Map is an interactive tool to help you find low-cost, accessible food and nutrition resources in the County. Bus routes are also added on the map.

<u>Howard County Food Bank.</u> - access to shopping twice a month for families that meet eligibility requirements. Walk-ins and appointments available.

<u>Columbia Community Care</u>- Provides food, hygiene items, household supplies and baby supplies to families in Howard County. Distribution sites are at the Wilde Lake Interfaith Center, The Other Barn in Oakland Mills, and the Long Reach Village Center, on Saturdays from 10 am - 12 pm. Delivery Service is available, and you may re-order food for delivery every 7 days.

#### **KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION**

Kindergarten enrollment for the 2023-2024 school year is underway! Children must be 5 years old by September 1 in order to enroll in kindergarten. Every child who is 5 years old by September 1 must be enrolled in a kindergarten program or have an approved waiver. HCPSS kindergarten is a full day program.

It is recommended that you work on a laptop or desktop to complete registration. Packets are available in the front office as well.
