TRANSPORTATION COMMUNICATION (Car Loop)

For the safety of students, staff, and families, when bringing students to school or picking up students from school by car, please access one of the following two options only:

- 1. **Join the parent-drop off line**, where your child(ren) will be greeted when invited to exit the vehicle curbside. Your child will then use a staff-monitored crosswalk to safely access the front of the building.
- 2. **Park your car in a parking space** and escort your child(ren) to the sidewalk in front of the building.

In addition, thank you for reframing from:

- Parking along sidewalks or curbed areas
- Allowing students to cross the parking lot using crosswalks that are not monitored by staff members
- Exiting the parking using the lower lot as it is reserved for buses

Thank you for following our drop-off and pick-up procedures to ensure the safety of all members of our HES School Community.


PE'S FUN RUN

FALL MAP ASSESSMENTS

Students in grades 1-5 will take the Measured Academic Progress (MAP) assessment during the month of September or October. The data from the MAP assessment will help schools and teachers measure your student's academic progress. The MAP test does not affect grades and the difficulty adjusts depending on how your child responds. It is normal for students to only answer about half the questions correctly. Teachers in grades 1-5 will administer the assessment on the dates listed below. If your child is absent, makeup testing will be offered when they return to school. Teachers will share specific dates or changes to dates with you via Canvas announcements.

FROM THE HEALTH ROOM

There will be a flu vaccine clinic at Hammond Elementary. Maryland Partnership for Prevention, in partnership with the Howard County Health Department and Howard County Public Schools, will be hosting a flu vaccine clinic on Friday, October 28th.
